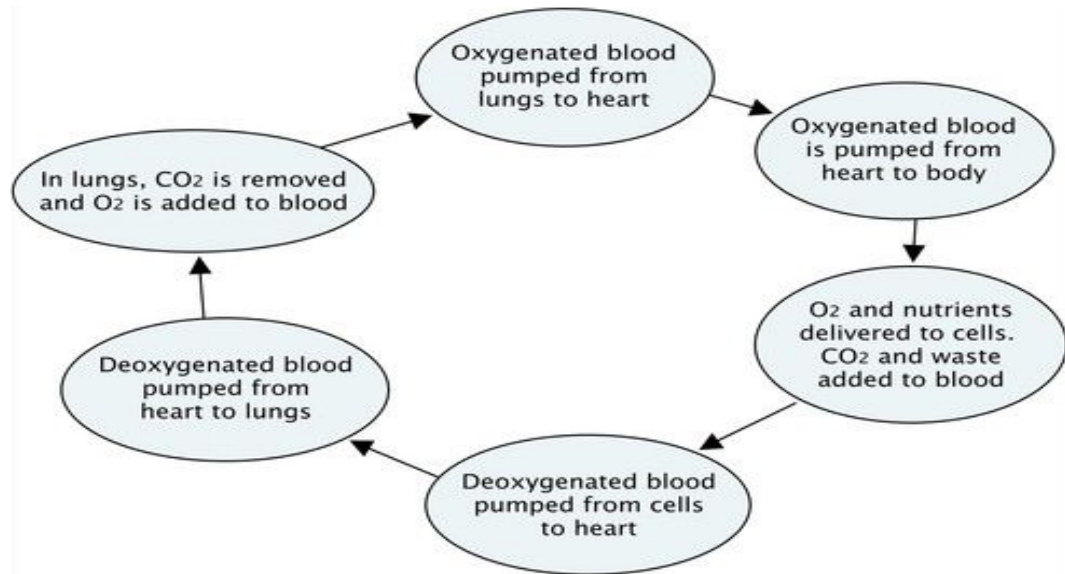


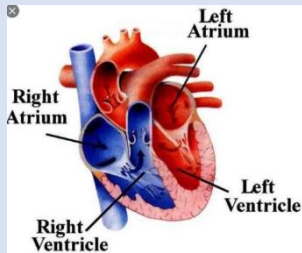
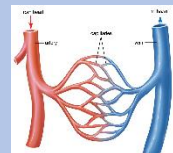
Science

The circulatory system is made up of three parts:

Word	Definition	Picture
1. Aorta	The largest artery in the body. It carries oxygenated blood away from the left ventricle to the body.	
2. Atrium (right/left)	Upper chambers of the heart through which blood enters the ventricles.	
3. Ventricle (right/left)	Muscular chambers that pump blood out of the heart to the lungs or the rest of the body.	
4. Vena cava	A large vein that carries deoxygenated blood from the body back to the heart.	
5. Vessel	A tube through which the blood circulates in the body.

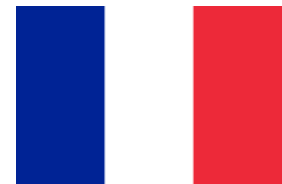

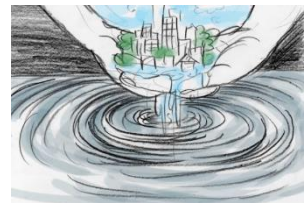

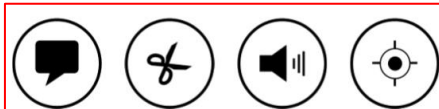
