

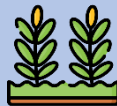
Geography

- What different climates can you find in South America and how does this affect its vegetation belt?
- Why is the Amazon Rainforest important to South America and the rest of the world?



Key vocabulary

Word	Definition	Picture
<i>tropical</i>	A tropical climate is hot and wet and found close to the Equator where energy from the sun is more concentrated.	
<i>biomes</i>	Areas of the planet with a similar climate and landscape, where similar animals and plants live.	
<i>vegetation</i>	Plants or plant life growing in a particular place.	
<i>deforestation</i>	The process of clearing or cutting down forests.	
<i>indigenous</i>	Being the original people to live in a particular place.

We will be creating Maya structures using wire and clay moulds. We will explore different moulding techniques such as coil and slab.



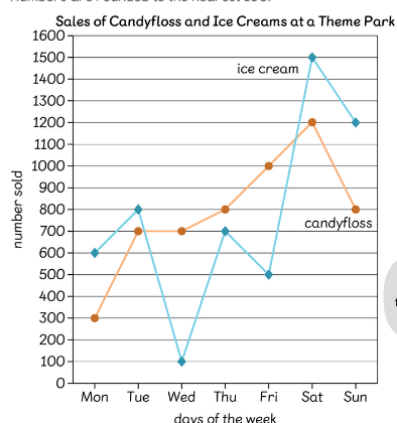
Inspiration from the Greats - Aneta Regel
