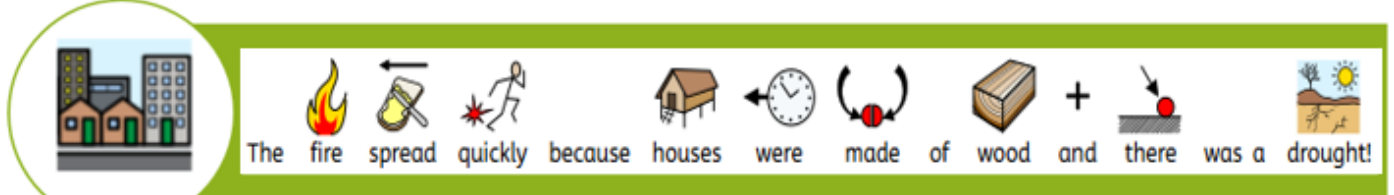
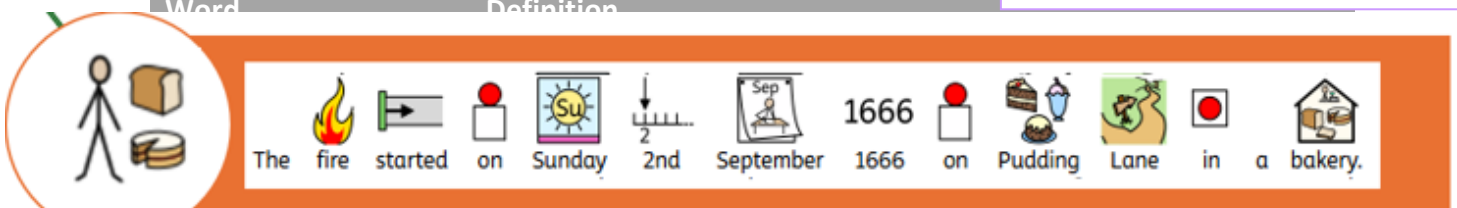
This half term, we will be researching animal classifications and learning about the human body and our senses!

mammals	warm-blooded animals such as cats, cows, dogs and pigs	
amphibians	cold-blooded animals such as frogs, toads and newts	
reptiles	cold-blooded animals such as snakes, lizards and crocodiles	
live young	a baby that is not hatched from an egg	
nurse	the method by which newborn mammals are nourished
