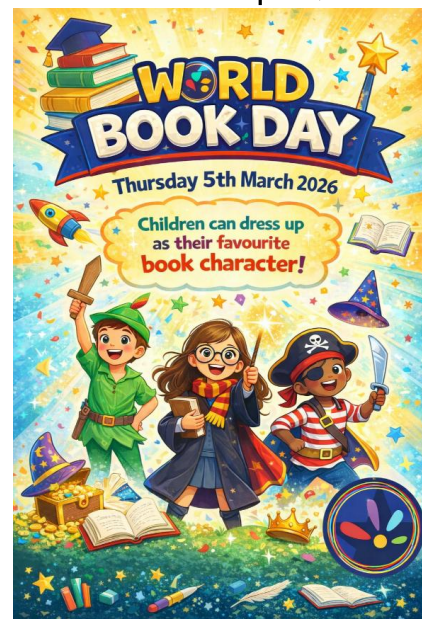
Scholastic book fair will be in school on Thursday 5th March 3-3.45pm
