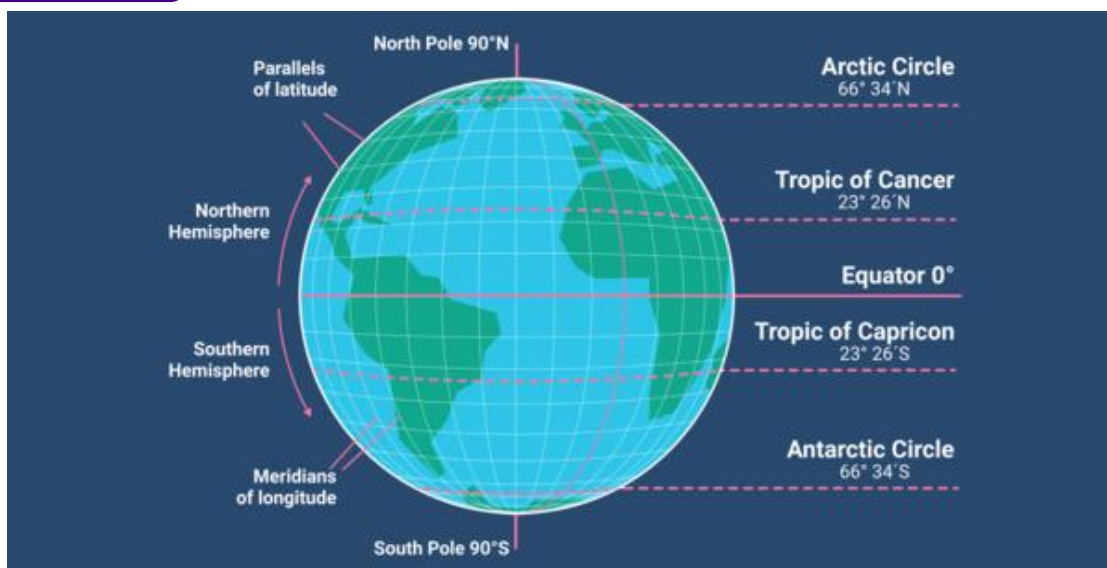


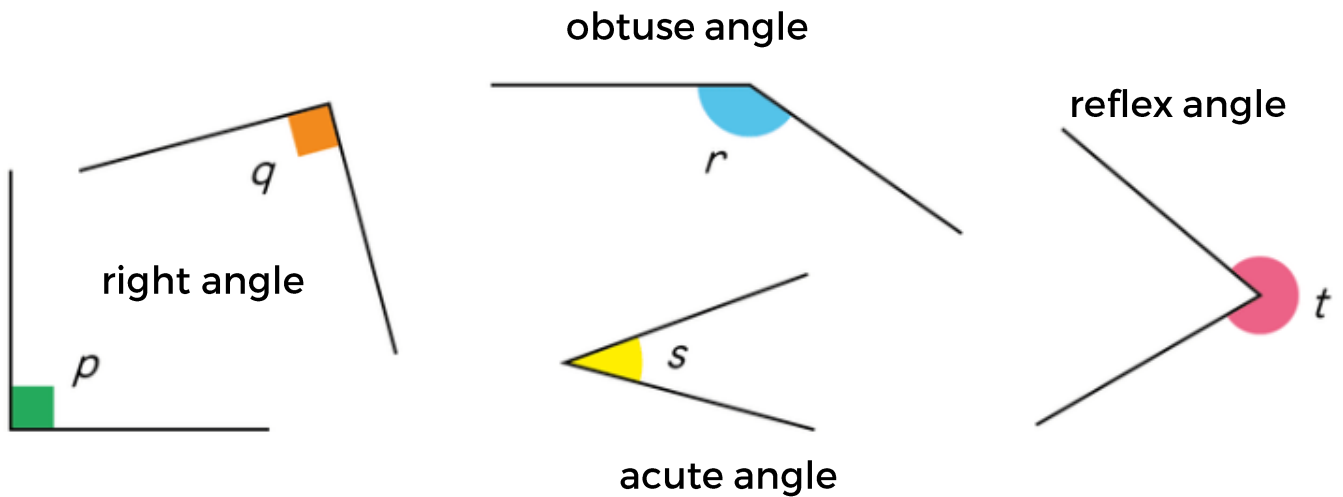

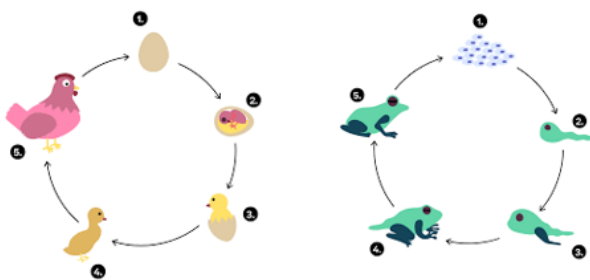
Key vocabulary

<u>Word</u>	<u>Definition</u>
<i>latitude</i>	Latitude measures the distance north or south of the equator. Lines of latitude are measured in degrees north or south of the equator to 90 degrees at the North or South poles.
<i>longitude</i>	Lines of longitude are imaginary lines that divide the Earth. They run north to south from pole to pole, but they measure the distance east or west.
<i>tropic</i>	The tropics are regions of Earth that lie roughly in the middle of the globe.
<i>Greenwich Meridian</i>	The time zone we follow in the UK.
<i>hemisphere</i>	A hemisphere is half of a sphere, or ball. People use the word to describe one half of Earth.

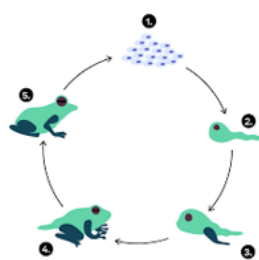

We are going to use a variety of electrical circuits to create our own electrical 'doodlers'.

A 'doodler' is an electrical device that uses a motor to generate a wobbly offset spin and to scribble jagged circles and patterns.



Circuit

a collection of components that create an electrical circuit.
