<i>slavery</i>		A condition of having to work very hard without proper pay or appreciation.
<i>colony</i>		A group of people of one nationality or race living in a foreign place.
<i>abolished</i>		To formally put an end to (a system, practice, or institution).

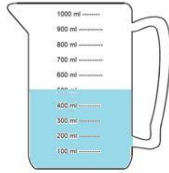

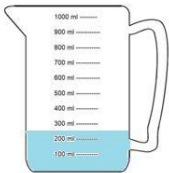
1000ml = 1 litre



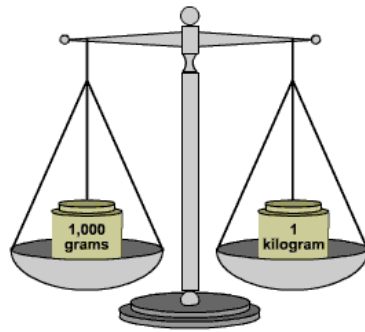
750ml = $\frac{3}{4}$ of a litre



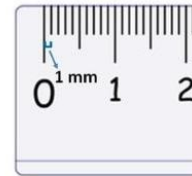
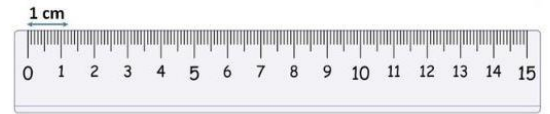
500ml = $\frac{1}{2}$ of a litre
