

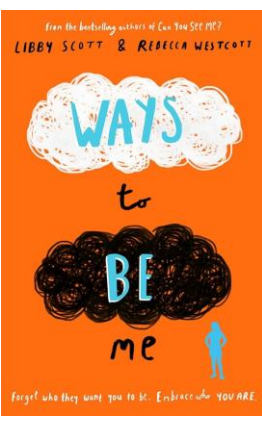
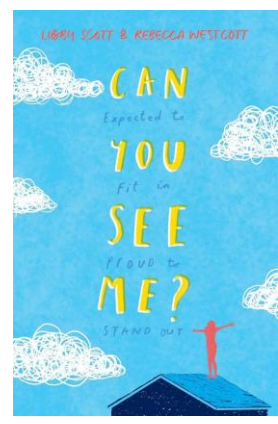


Key text: The Final Year

Geography: Migration

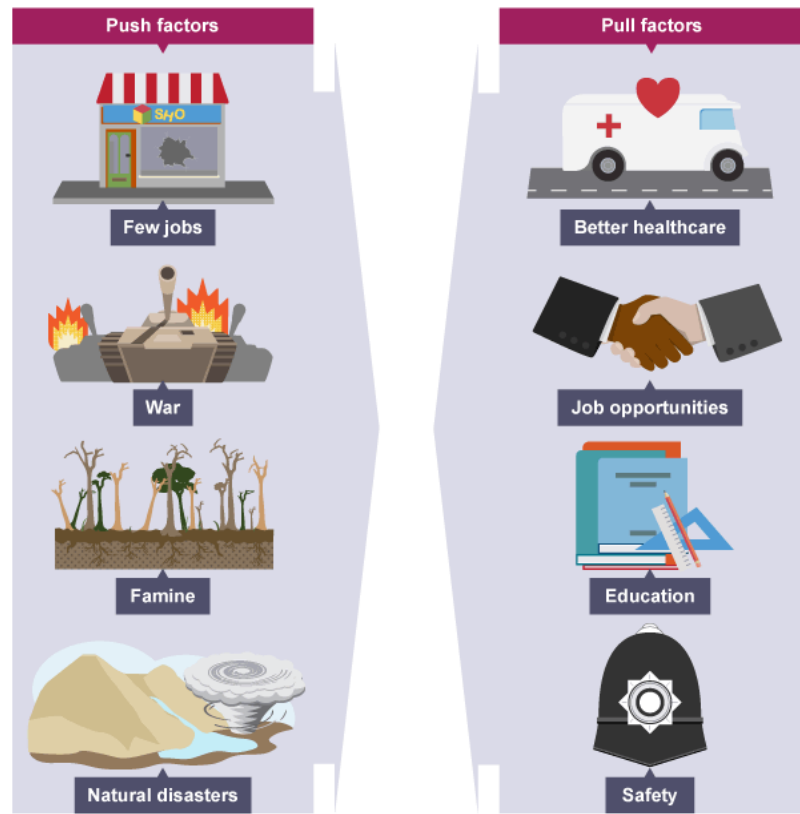
Word	Definition	Picture
Migrate	Move to a new area or country in order to find work or better living conditions	
Asylum	The protection granted by a state to someone who has left their home country as a political refugee	
Uninhabitable	Unsuitable for living in	
Immigration	The action of coming to live permanently in a foreign country	
Emigration	The act of leaving one's own country to settle permanently

Migration Factors:

The reasons for migrating can be broadly categorised as push and pull factors.

Pull factors are seen as positive things that attract people to a particular place.

Push factors are the negative things that make people want to move away.



Impacts of migration:

Migration can bring advantages and disadvantages to the areas in which the migrants move to.

Advantages	Disadvantages

Helps to reduce any labour shortages	Overcrowding

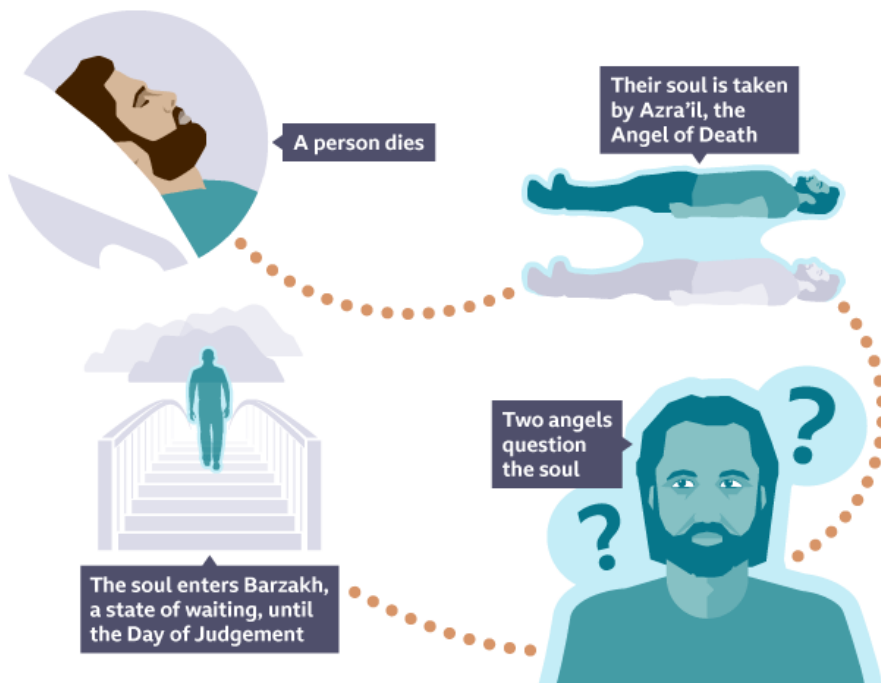
Jihad has two meanings for Muslims. It is both a struggle for faith and a struggle against evil.

Greater Jihad is about making the effort to be a good Muslim through a personal struggle to improve spiritually. It is a duty and an act of worship.

Righteous is morally right or justifiable.

After death, most Muslims believe that the soul will enter Barzakh, a state of waiting, until the Day of Judgement.

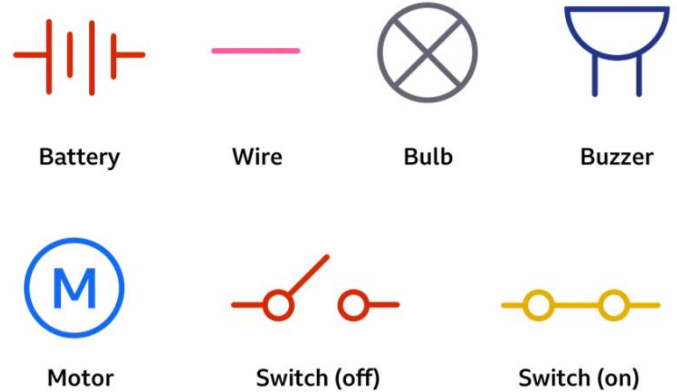
- When a person dies, their soul is taken by Azra'il, the Angel of Death.
- God sends two angels to question the waiting soul.
- If the questions are answered correctly, the good soul then sleeps during Barzakh.
- If the questions are not answered correctly, the soul is tormented by angels, known as punishment of the grave.



A circuit is a closed loop containing various components. Electrical current flows around the circuit. Scientists use symbols to represent the different components in a circuit.

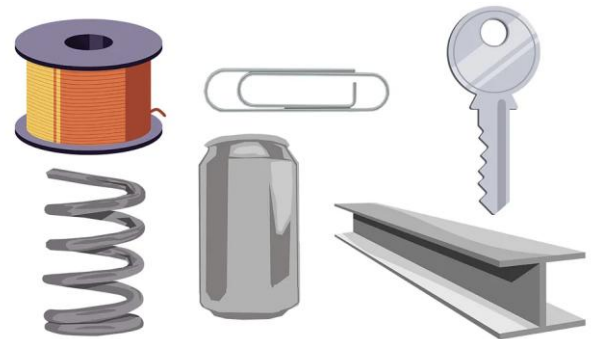
A circuit will always have a battery (cell) as well as other components. Components, such as **bulbs**, **buzzers**, **switches** and **motors**, need a battery in order to work.

Circuit Symbols:



Some materials let electricity pass through them easily. These materials are known as electrical conductors.

Many **metals**, such as **copper**, **iron** and **steel**, are good electrical conductors. That is why the parts of electrical objects that need to let electricity pass through are always made of **metal**.



Some materials do not allow electricity to pass through them. These materials are known as electrical insulators.

Plastic, **wood**, **glass** and **rubber** are good electrical insulators. That is why they are used to cover materials that carry electricity.

The plastic covering, that surrounds wires, is an electrical insulator. It stops you from getting an electrical shock.
